Seven Sisters is a multi-cultural area of North London popular for its location on key road and underground rail routes. Haringey Council is committed to an on-going programme of regenerating the local area to attract both residents and the business community. According to research by Bilfinger GVA, Haringey will see a 23 per cent increase in jobs by 2036, nearly double that in Zone One.

Uniquely positioned for access to Stansted airport via the tube at Seven Sisters and national rail services, the Lawrence Square scheme is just down the line from Google's headquarters at King's Cross. The London Overground station connects to Liverpool Street in the south and Enfield Town and Cheshunt to the north. The A10 leads to the A406 (North Circular) and on to the M25 and M11. The Victoria Line tube has fast services north to Walthamstow and south to Kings Cross, Victoria and Vauxhall.
